1. All events are on Friday. Starting times to be announced on the SCASpueblo Facebook page.
2. The CSU-P Observatory is located on the hill south of the Raptor Center. Parking is free in the Raptor Center lot (see the map).
3. Be prepared to walk up the lighted dirt path to the observatory on top of the hill. A flashlight with a red lens is recommended.
4. In addition to viewing the the 22-inch observatory telescope, SCAS volunteers will have scopes available for viewing the night sky from the base of the hill.
